Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 05-01-15 through 05-31-15

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 162 calls for service for the month of May 2015.

The Department reports 7 custodial arrest statistics this month. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department reports 31 total citations listing 37 traffic violations, 4 misdemeanor violations, 3 Felony violations and 14 verbal warnings for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

Training:

64 training hours are reported this month. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) I met with the County Prosecutor reference Sheridan Dr. non-motorized trail enforcement options.
- 2) I met with the leadership of the Sheridan Dr Association reference enforcement expectations of the non-motorized trail. Additionally, we discussed the address changes that are necessary for same.
- 3) I participated with ACT-NOW in the Annual Spring road clean-up project which encompasses Pioneer Hill to Hillsdale Dr on Co Rd 100.
- 4) I attended the Gerrish Township work session as required.
- 5) I attended the ACT-NOW Executive Board meeting in my Advisory role.
- 6) I attended the Northern Michigan Children's Assessment Center team case review meeting on behalf of the Department.
- 7) I met with Fire Chief Lippert, 911 Director Vance Stringham and the County Tax Assessment Department regarding the necessary address changes for former Sheridan Dr addresses.
- 8) I hosted and attended the 2015 Sunrise Run Safety coordination meeting here at the Police Department and received resource commitment from the stakeholders for this year's event.
- 9) I met with the Law Enforcement committee of the 911 Technical Board and the 911 Director regarding Commission on Aging/Meals on wheels welfare check protocol for dispatching Officers.
- 10) I attended the regular Gerrish Township Board meeting as required.
- 11) I held two staff meetings this month covering several topics of importance for summer enforcement concerns.

12) I attended the MACP Legislative meeting via conference call to discuss the new legislation that will effect Law Enforcement in Michigan. The bills are reviewed for a position for the MACP as it represents the 619 Police agencies in Michigan.

13) I attended the monthly Roscommon County Law Enforcement Administrators lunch at Fred's Restaurant in Roscommon.

14) I attended the AVI meeting at the Roscommon County Commissioners office in preparation for the full scale exercise scheduled for 9-2-15 at the RAPS campus.

15) I attended the Roscommon County Community Corrections Authority Board meeting in my board member capacity to discuss the new grant submission and future programs.

Highlights this month for the Department include;

We had a very busy Memorial Day weekend overall and the staff here handled things very well. For the most part, dock placing and permits have been coming along well.

GTPD, GTFD/EMS, CERT, ACT NOW and the Roscommon County Road Commission met to correlate services for the annual Higgins Lake Sunrise Run. Organizers have provided us with a route for this years run to include the 13.1 half marathon, 10k and 5k. Preparations for all the deployments are being made for the run scheduled Saturday June 20, 2015. We will be assisted by MSP and the Sheriff's office along the route of the 13.1 marathon.

The "Scrap Metal Project" is up and in full swing and seems to be doing well again this year. As a reminder, you may drop off items of scrap and ACT-NOW will dispose of same and the use of the funds will be for Community projects to included scholarships at the local High School, Shop with a Cop, winter heating assistance for the elderly, etc.

The ACT-NOW trailer is placed next to the impound lot and ready for people to drop off their metal in the trailer.

As a reminder again, there will not be a June ACT NOW community meeting in lieu of ACT NOW's participation in the June 20, 2015 Higgins Lake Sunrise Run.
