## ***Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 07-01-15 through 07-31-15***

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 206 calls for service for the month of July 2014.

The Department reports 51 total citations recording 58 traffic violations, 12 Misdemeanor violations and 13 written verbal warnings. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department also reports 10 custodial arrests for the monthly period. (See attached report for breakdown).

### Training:

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 10) I chaired and attended the 911 Technical Board meeting at Central Dispatch in my Chairperson role.
- 11) I met with and arranged for the order of 3 office outlook 2013 application to be installed on three workstations in the office to conclude the technology upgrade plan for this year.

12) I attended the monthly Law Enforcement Administrators luncheon meeting held at Freds Restaurant in Roscommon.

13) I attended the ACT NOW Annual picnic and meeting where I conducted the elections for the organization in my Advisory role. Additionally, I served as the nominating committee and awards committee for the Citizen of the year award which went to John Kline for his role as a GAP 1 Representative on the board and a very valuable ACT-NOW member.
