

Supervisors Report May 2015 Meeting

Since my last report I have worked on township business all of or part of 29 day, with hours totaling 219. A partial breakdown of those hours follows. I chaired 1 regular board meeting, 1 Work session, 1 Special meeting, I attended 1 RTA meeting, 1 transit authority meeting, 1 act now meeting, 1 park and rec. meeting, 2 Co .Commission work sessions as well as 2 Co. Commission meetings, I attended along with Commissioner Melvin the Mi. Lakes and Streams Conference that was recently held at Boyne. I have been working with the chamber on the free fishing weekend event, I have met and spoke with many citizens both in and out of the office, on roads, swimmers itch, water levels, refuse and recycle issues. I have also spent many hours at the marina getting that ready for summer start up. The crew there has done a great job, we are actually ahead of schedule.

I have been working many hours along with North Point on the swimmers itch comprehensive plan. As of this report we have turned in to Blankenspoor 21 Mergansers 16 of them being female . This should make a good impact on parasite releases this year as well as the number of young ducks born this spring approximately +- 190. We hope to dispatch the remaining 4 ducks prior to our end date. Due to the activity on the lake in the interest of safety we are holding off for a bad weather day when people are not using the lake.

Dr. Luttenton has been up to the lake 3 times getting snail samples for study. He is not charging us for his time as he is interested in the problem.
