Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 11-01-15 through 11-30-15

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 88 calls for service for the month November 2015.

The Department reports 16 total citations listing 18 traffic violations, 7 written verbal warnings, and 1 misdemeanor statistics for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

The Department reports 1 custodial arrests for the month. (See attached arrest report).

Training:

A total of 18.0 contact hrs. of training are reported for this month. An additional 15.0 Credit hrs. were achieved through Learn.com, our online Policy training location. (See attached detail document).
