

Resolution: Adopting A Final Project Plan For Wastewater System Improvements

WHEREAS, Gerrish Township, Roscommon County, Michigan recognizes the need for protection of the groundwater (drinking water source) and near shore surface water quality of Higgins Lake from continued degradation due to individual septic discharges along the near shore area, and this action will be facilitated by expanding the existing municipal sanitary sewer collection system in the proposed project area; and

WHEREAS, Gerrish Township, Roscommon County, Michigan, with the support and concurrence of the Lyon Township and Beaver Creek Township Boards, authorized C2AE to prepare a Project Plan for the near shore areas of Higgins Lake that includes Gerrish, Lyon and Beaver Creek Townships, which said plan recommends the construction of Treatment Alternative #4 – Connect to the Existing HLUA WWTF and Collection Alternative #8 – Pressure Sewer Collection System, all located in Lyon Township; and

WHEREAS, said Project Plan was presented at a Public Hearing held on June 18, 2014 and all public comments have be considered and addressed;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Gerrish Township, Roscommon County, Michigan supports the action of the Lyon Township Board on June 18, 2014 in formally adopting the “No Action Alternative” of said Project Plan. As the recommended project does not currently include any areas of Gerrish Township, no further action is proposed by Gerrish Township at this time
