OLD AGE AND SURVIVORS' INSURANCE

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Social Security Act has been so amended by the Congress of the United States as to permit political subdivisions of the several states to extend to their employees and officers the benefits of Old Age and Survivors' Insurance, and

WHEREAS, The Michigan Legislature in regular session enacted Public Act No. 205, P.A. 1951, as amended, to enable the State of Michigan or political subdivisions thereof to secure coverage for their employees under the Old Age and Survivors' Insurance provisions of Title II of the Social Security Act as amended, and

WHEREAS, An agreement has been entered into between the State of Michigan and the Secretary of Health and Human Services to extend the benefits of the federal Old Age and Survivors' Insurance system to employees of the state or of any political subdivision thereof.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, That the governing body of Gerrish Township Michigan, hereby elects coverage under the Old Age and Survivors' Insurance, as provided by Act No. 205, P.A. 1951, as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Ivan S. Willett

(Official Title), be, and is hereby authorized and directed on behalf of Gerrish Township
(Political Subdivision) to enter into agreement with the department for the

extension of the benefits under Title II of the Social Security Act subject to the provisions of Sec. 8 of Act No. 205, P.A. 1951, as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the proper fiscal officers be, and they are, hereby authorized to make all required payments into the Contribution Fund established by the said Enabling Act and to establish such system of payroll deductions from the salaries of employees and officers as may be necessary to their coverage under said Old Age and Survivors' Insurance System.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the proper officials of the state or of the political subdivision do all things necessary to the continued implementation of said system.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED, That any funds payable to the Gerrish Township
(Political Subdivision)

from any department of the State of Michigan may be withheld by said department and transferred to the State Employees' Retirement Board to be used in the payment of any default on

the part of Gerrish Township

in accordance with paragraph V (c) of the contract between the State of Michigan and _____
