

**IMPOUND VEHICLE ORDINANCE
GERRISH TOWNSHIP, MICHIGAN
ORDINANCE No. XXX**

Certificate of Adoption

At a regular meeting of the Township Board of Gerrish held on Tuesday, July 20, 1999, the following resolution was adopted:

Upon motion by Ragan, supported by Boyle:

That Impound Vehicle Ordinance No. XXX be accepted as amended and presented. Ordinance to be effective upon publication:

**An Ordinance To Establish User Fees For The Impounding
Of Vehicles Taken Into Possession By Order Of The
Gerrish Township Police Department**

The Township Board of the Township of Gerrish Ordains:

**SECTION I
DEFINITIONS**

For the purposes of this Ordinance the following definitions apply:

- 1.1 "Vehicle" – means every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway
- 1.2 "Police Department" – means the Police Department of Gerrish Township, Roscommon County, Michigan
- 1.3 "Registered Owner" – means the person who holds the legal title and/or registration to a vehicle
- 1.4 "Township" – means Gerrish Township, Roscommon County, Michigan

**SECTION II
FEES**

A minimum fee of \$25.00 shall be paid to the Township prior to the release of any vehicle taken into custody or impounded by the Police Department except that the vehicle remains in impound for a period greater than 5 days. In the event a vehicle would remain in impound for a period of greater than 5 days, the additional fee is \$5.00 per day past the first 5 days. In addition and prior to a vehicle being released, the owner shall present to

the releasing officer a receipt from the wrecker service that towed the vehicle showing that all wrecker charges have been paid.

SECTION III
WAIVER OF FEE

The fee in Section II may be waived by the Township in those instances where the vehicle was impounded by the order of the Police Department under circumstances where the registered owner did not violate any state, local, or federal law.


