

ORDINANCE NO. 8

An ordinance to adopt by reference the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages.

The Township of Gerrish ordains:

Sec. 1. CODE ADOPTED

The Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages promulgated by the Commissioner of State Police on February 14, 1958 and published in Supplement No. 13, and as amended both on February 14, 1961 and published in Supplement No. 25, and on February 26, 1968 and published in Supplement No. 54, to the 1954 Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Public Act 62 of 1956, State of Michigan, is hereby adopted by reference as in this ordinance modified.

Sec. 2. REFERENCES IN CODE

References in the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan Cities, Townships and Villages to "governmental unit" shall mean the Township of Gerrish.


Sec. 3. NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED


The Gerrish Township Clerk shall publish this ordinance in the manner required by law and shall at the same time publish a supplementary notice setting forth the purpose of the said Uniform Traffic Code and of the fact that complete copies of the Code are available at the office of the Clerk for inspection by and distribution to the public at all atimes.

Sec. 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE

The Uniform Traffic Code will be in effect in this governmental unit 30 days after the passage of this adopting ordinance.


NOTICE of ADOPTION of UNIFORM TRAFFIC CODE

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to the provisions of Act 62 of the Public Acts of 1956, State of Michigan, the Uniform Traffic Code for cities, townships and villages was adopted by reference by the Board of the Township of Gerrish on the 22nd day of July, 1971.

The purpose of such Code is to regulate the operation of vehicles, to provide for the regulation and use of streets, highways and alleys and other public and semi-public places within the Township of Gerrish and to provide penalties for the violation of said Code.

Complete copies of the Uniform Traffic Code are available at the office of the Township Clerk for inspection by and distribution to the public at all times.

No further or additional publication of the Uniform Traffic Code is required or contemplated.

ORDINANCE NO. 8

An ordinance to adopt by reference amendments to the Uniform Traffic Code for Michigan cities, townships, and villages.

The TOWNSHIP OF GERRISH ordains:

Section 1. AMENDMENTS TO CODE ADOPTED

Amendments A of the Uniform Traffic Code for Cities, Townships, and Villages, and B, all of which were promulgated by the Director of the Department of State Police, effective January 27, 1981 and published in Quarterly Supplement No. 5 to the 1979 edition of the Michigan Administrative Code, in accordance with Act No. 62 of the Michigan Public Acts of 1956, are hereby adopted by reference amending and adding similarly numbered sections of Ordinance No. 8 adopted on July 22, 1971 as amended on August 20, 1979 and January 21, 1993.

Section 2. NOTICE TO BE PUBLISHED

The Township Clerk shall publish this ordinance amendment in the manner required by law, and the fact that a complete copy of the code as hereby amended is available at the office of the Clerk for inspection by the public at all times.

Section 3. CHANGES IN CODE: Section 9.3 shall read as follows:

Section 9.3. Penalties; civil infraction and misdemeanor.


- (1) Civil infraction: A violation of this code or rules substantially corresponding to the act that is designated a civil infraction is not a crime and shall not be punishable by imprisonment. A civil infraction shall not be considered a lesser included offense of any criminal offense.
 - i) A civil infraction violation other than a parking violation shall be punished by a civil fine of not more than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and costs as provided in Michigan Compiled Laws, Section 257.907, as amended.
 - ii) A civil infraction violation which is a parking violation shall be punished by a civil fine of no less than Twenty Five (\$25.00) Dollars plus costs.
- (2) Misdemeanor: Unless another penalty is expressly provided by the ordinance of this governmental unit, every person who is convicted of a misdemeanor violation of any provision of this code shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 90 days, or both.

Section 4. WHEN EFFECTIVE

This ordinance will be in effect thirty (30) days after passage.
