### **SUPERVISOR REPORT SEPTEMBER 12, 2017**

The following is a summary of my activities for the previous month.

On August 8<sup>th</sup>. I chaired the monthly township meeting.

I attended the Roscommon County Commissioner's meeting on August 9.

I have met with and had communication with the RCRC regarding both certified road township projects, and non-certified road projects.

During the month of August, I met with Higgins Lake residents to hear their concerns regarding the health of Higgins Lake.

On Monday August 21, I chaired the annual public hearing to review the Police and Fire-EMS budget for 2018.

On Tuesday August 24, I attended a closed session meeting of the Township Board to discuss the settlement of litigation against the township.

During the month of August, I have had the opportunity to meet with several residents who came into the office to discuss their concerns. I have also met with residents at their homes when asked.

At the Gerrish Township Marina, the cool weather, coupled with the early start of school down state resulted in a decline of activity and gas sales. Several slip renters have pulled their boats allowing their boat lifts to be removed for the season. Currently there are 160 requests for seasonal boat slips.

The roof on the marina building where the ice skating took place in previous years has separated allowing rain water to enter and collect on the boards that surround the ice rink area. Black mold was discovered growing on the ice rink boards. A mold evaluation was performed to identify exactly what type of mold existed. The test results identified no air born mold issues due to the fact that the mold is still wet. However, the black mold on the boards needs to be addressed. (1) A chemical treatment can be applied to the existing boards.
