Marina Manager Report October 5, 2017

In spite of the summer-like weather in September, the marina experienced slow gas sales. We had several days where there were no sales. The marina officially closed for the season on September 30.

- Work days were scheduled during September when boats were removed for the season in sufficient numbers.
- All customer boats were removed from their lifts by Sunday October 1.
- Work began on Monday October 2 to remove all finger docks and main docks. As of this date, 2 of the 4 main docks and finger docks have been removed and stored.
- The main gas dock power cable, and the low-voltage power cables have been removed, coiled, and are now stored inside the marina building. These critical cables will no longer remain outside in the winter weather.
- Safety modifications to the work barge are working as designed.
- Further modifications to the work barge are being considered for next season. These involve ramps for loading cantilever boat lifts onto the deck of the barge, eliminating the need for workers to lift while loading.
- We estimate that three work days remain to get all equipment stored for the winter.
- The preparation for winter at Carlos Park is almost complete. The swim buoy's have been removed and stored. The park facilities are now closed for the season. Water will be drained for the winter and the septic tank will be pumped.
