

Supervisors Report September 2016

Since my last report I have worked on Township Business all or part of 35 days with hours totaling 241 hours. A partial break down follows.

I chaired 1 regular board meeting, 2 special police/fire budget hearings. One regular work session, 1 special interview session, Attended 1 RCTA meeting as a voting member, Two 911 meetings. I had contact with our Township attorneys office several times ref. Township business. Worked on the last road brining detail for the year. I met with the Township Risk Mgt. representative with favorable reports on the township Risk reduction plans. I worked many hours at the Marina, and handled several issues at the Carlos Park. Worked on several refuse, issues as well as many day to day visits by residents. The Marina Customer Appreciation Day went well with 400 or so people attending through out the day.

I am very happy that after many years of efforts this Board has finally been able to achieve a step in protecting our lake by creating a point of Sale Septic ordinance. This is a small step to bettering the lakes water quality for the future. I thank the hard work of the planning commission and all of those behind the scenes that have helped us to get to this point. It is unfortunate that it has taken 14 or more years. Just stop to think how much better the lakes water quality would be if more steps were taken years ago to protect our great natural resource. I can only hope that after I leave office that this and future boards continue to take additional steps to move forward with at least mandatory septic inspections and in some cases cluster septic sytems.
