Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 10-01-16 through 10-31-16

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 100 calls for service for the month of October 2016.

The Department reports 10 various custodial arrest statistics this month. (See attached reports for breakdown).

The Department reports 33 citations listing 29 traffic violations, 13 misdemeanor violations and 22 verbal warnings for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

Training:

A total of 30 contact hours of training are reported for the month of October 2016. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the month reported as follows:

- 1) I attended the ACT-NOW Executive Board meeting in my advisory role.
- 2) I attended the regular scheduled Gerrish Township Board work session.
- 3) I coordinated and provided Incident Command for the 2016 "Walk to School Day" for the Roscommon Area Public Schools.
- 4) I met with the Higgins Lake Property Owners Association Riparian Committee to discuss P.A. 56 Enforcement and other Riparian concerns regarding roads in Higgins Lake at their request.
- 5) I planned, coordinated and participated in the large CERT 3rd Quarter training exercise that occurred in multiple places throughout the Township.
- 6) I chaired and attended the Roscommon County 911 Technical Board meeting in my Chairperson role.
- 7) I attended, trained and qualified with our Department firearms as required.
- 8) I attended the monthly NMCAC team review at the NMCAC in Roscommon reviewing CSC/Child Abuse and neglect cases.
- 9) I attended the Roscommon County Law Enforcement Administrators meeting and lunch at Fred's Restaurant in Roscommon.
- 10) I volunteered to assist the Roscommon Area Public schools by manning the concession stand for the Roscommon High School Homecoming Football game so that the Junior class could enjoy the festivities. I did this along with other Roscommon County Law Enforcement agencies.

- 11) I met with the North East Michigan Senior Volunteer Coordinator to talk about a partnership that could bolster our volunteer numbers in our community and yet provide them with the benefits offered by their organization.
- 12) I attended a webinar sponsored by the Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police to explore the new Accreditation program to glean more information on the possibility of our Police Department going through the process.
- 13) I attended the Roscommon County Local Emergency Planning team meeting.
- 14) I attended one Trunk or Treat 2016 event planning meeting.
- 15) I hosted and chaired a safety meeting regarding the 2016 Trunk or Treat event to discuss traffic flow and traffic assignments for the safety of the event.
- 16) I met with Treasurer Tulgetske and the Ricoh USA representatives regarding proposed copy machine replacements.
- 17) I conducted one staff meeting this month.
- 18) During the month, I was gone for a week vacation.
- 19) I have been and will continue to collaboratively work with the Building/Zoning Department regarding several properties in the Township that are in a state of disrepair and have become an eye sore to the community and the aesthetic beauty of our community and property values.
- 20) I volunteered and participated in the set up, operational time and clean-up of the 2016 Trunk or Treat hosted by the Police Department and ACT-NOW. Great weather was abound and we saw a huge turnout and although we do not take an actual count, we believe this was best year ever in attendance with an estimated 1000 people plus attending.
- 21) I authored a Roscommon Rotary Grant in the amount of \$15,000.00 to contribute to "The Boot" program and was advised that the grant has been approved. I wrote the grant on behalf of the Friends for Safe Schools fund which is housed in the Roscommon County Community Foundation.

Additional Information:

The 8th Annual Trunk or Treat event was held on 10-31-16 in great weather conditions without incident. The event was very well supported by Community Partners to include the Police, Fire/EMS, CERT, ACT-NOW, and the Gerrish Township Board. Without these partnerships and cooperation, these types of events would never happen. On behalf of the Police Department, I would like to extend a huge thank you to all who participated, volunteered or supported this event. A special thanks to the Co-Chairs Officer Eric Muszynski and Gerrish Township Treasurer Leasa Tulgetske.

In other news;

Our Department has been actively involved in "The Boot" being installed in our school buildings at the RAPS campus. We are actively participating in the marketing campaign to pay for costs involved in the effort. "Adopt a Door" brochures have gone out to various locations in the Township soliciting donations. Since this is a County wide effort, many other partners are involved. To date, the RAPS District has provided over \$14,000.00 which represents a third of the total \$55,000.00 plus amount due on the entire project of installing this mechanism on 187 doors at the District. With the recently approved \$15,000.00 grant approval through the Roscommon Rotary, the project is half

funded now. The best news of all is that "The Lockdown Company", owners of "The Boot" product started installing the devices on our school doors on October 21, 2016. We are very excited about this additional layer of protection for our children while in their learning environment.

Officers of our Department will be picking up the applications seeking assistance from the Shop with a Cop program from the Roscommon Elementary School just prior to Thanksgiving 2016. After a vetting process, shopping for the 2016 Shop with a Cop program will begin the first week of December with our Officers taking the oldest child shopping for the family and providing dinner with the Officers the same night.

As a note, the October drug take back initiative and regular collection of the drop off location netted 35.6 pounds for destruction. OFFICER transported the product to the Petoskey Department of Public Safety where it was taken to incineration in Grand Rapids pursuant to our grant with the Northern Michigan Tip of the Mitt Watershed Council. Thank you to all who use the box and keep the product from finding its way into our community or ground water.
