Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 10-01-12 through 10-31-12

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 116 calls for service for the month October 2012.

The Department reports 12 various custodial arrest statistics this month. (See attached reports for breakdown).

The Department reports 61 citations listing 70 traffic violations, 10 misdemeanor violations and 16 verbal warnings for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

Training:

A total of 30 hours of training are reported for this month. (See attached detail document).

- 7) I participated in the set up, operational time and clean up of the 2012 Trunk or Treat and Haunted Trail hosted by the Police Department.
- 8) I chaired and attended the 911 Law Enforcement Committee of the technical board for the purpose of discussing wrecker coverage and rotation issues as well as review of some SOP clarification issues as they relate to Law Enforcement.

- 9) I attended the International Chief of Police Conference in San Diego, CA. for four days and received some top of the line training at same. My trip was sponsored by the Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police representing the organization as their President.
