### *Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 03-01-21 through 03-31-21*

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 82 calls for service for the month of March 2021.

The Department reports 2 various custodial arrest statistics this month. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department reports 10 total citations listing 6 traffic violations, 2 misdemeanor violations, 1 Probate Court Civil Infraction and 1 Municipal Civil Infraction Burning Violation for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

#### Training:

The Department reports 103 hours of continuing education this month. (See attached document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month as follows:

- 1) This month, Julie Hill our certified CPR/AED instructor provided classes for our CERT Team members for renewal as well as CPR/AED and First Aid to the Good Shepherd Child Development Center personnel. The trainings were held at the GTPD Training room.
- 2) I participated in 3 Motorola CAD/RMS/JMS phone conferences regarding the progress of the project and certain concerns about some timing delays that have caused issues on our end.
- 3) I attended one Higgins Lake Sunrise Run Zoom meeting for the purpose of planning coordination of same for June 2021.
- 4) I attended the ACT-NOW Executive Board meeting in my advisory role to the group.
- 5) I chaired a 911 Technical Board meeting in my Board chairperson capacity to discuss matters of the operations at 911.
- 6) I attended the Gerrish Township Annual, Regular, and General Budget meetings.
- 7) This month I chaired the 9<sup>th</sup> District Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police meeting in Clare, Mi. as a Past President for the purposes of electing the 9<sup>th</sup> District Representative for the group that will sit on the MACP Executive Board.
- 8) Lt Patchin and I received Zoom training for the Licensing and Permits section of the CAD/RMS/JMS system.
- 9) I attended the NMCAC multi-disciplinary monthly meeting for the purposes of reviewing current child abuse and sexual assault cases that the center has been working on.

- 10) The department has been backgrounding a potential new police officer candidate this month resulting in several meetings regarding same with various individuals.
- 11) Lt Patchin and I attended the Annual Pipeline training via electronic media to learn about the pipelines and pipeline safety associated with them. Additionally, several CERT members also participated on behalf of the Township.
- 12) I hosted two staff meetings this month. The first one was for the purposes of being trained on the new Zoll AEDs by the company regional representative. Same have now been placed into service in our cars. The second staff meeting was attended by the Prosecutor and Richfield Township Department of Public Safety where the Prosecutor provided a Legal Update mostly centered on the new roll out of the 2020 Criminal Justice Reform Bills that became effective April 1, 2021.
- 13) I attended the Roscommon County Law Enforcement Administrator's meeting via electronic media.
- 14) I chaired a NMCAC regular board meeting in my chairperson role to conduct the center business.
- 15) Administrative Clerk Julie Hill and I attended a CAD/RMS/JMS system Fleet management module training via electronic media.
- 16) Lt Patchin and I additionally attended training on the CAD/RMS/JMS Michigan Incident Crime Report system (MICR) for the purposes of setting the parameters for reporting the required data.
- 17) Lt Patchin and I attended the Roscommon and Crawford County Administrator user group for the purposes of deciding if we were going to be able to move to the new Motorola software program by April 20, 2021. The Dispatch Center cannot meet the training requirement due to staff shortages and being unable to meet training requirements before the April 20, 2021 go live date. Decisions were made by all Departments to meet their needs.
- 18) The Department assisted the Roscommon County Area Ministerial Association's monthly COVID-19 Food Distribution to provide safe traffic pattern and control for the event.
- 19) This month, we were finally able to get Officer Socia to a Datamaster class provided by the State of Michigan to be able to operate the breathalyzer instrument. The class was held via an electronic media.
