### *Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 06-01-21 through 06-30-21*

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 172 calls for service for the month of June 2021.

The Department reports 4 custodial arrest statistics this listed period as COVID-19 procedures and jail lodging COVID-19 restrictions are still in place. In addition, we are now operating under the new Criminal Justice Reform bills from April 1, 2021, that restrict lodging 1 year and under misdemeanors. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department reports 17 total citations listing 14 traffic violations, 2 Misdemeanor violations, 1 Felony Citation and 7 verbal warnings for this listed period. (See attached for breakdown).

#### Training:

83 contact training hours are reported during this listed period. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) I attended the ACT-NOW Executive Board meeting in my Advisory role.
- 2) I attended the Gerrish Township Board work session as required to update the board on the operational status of the Department.
- 3) The Department and ACT-NOW awarded two \$1000.00 scholarships to two graduating seniors of the Roscommon High School.
- 4) The Department hosted 2 days of First Aid classes for the second quarter CERT training initiative.
- 5) This month, the Department assisted the HLPOA Riparian Committee with posting seven road ends in the Township with PA-56 of 2012 information signs. The road ends were identified by the Police Department of areas of concern from past activity. The sign designs were a collaborative effort of the HL Riparian Committee that meets twice a year to discuss Riparian issues.
- 6) I met with area Law Enforcement partners regarding the South Higgins Lake State Park for the purposes of discussing the Fourth of July potential activity at the park and a needs assessment for an enforcement effort at the park this year. We reviewed the data from past years, and it was determined that no formal task force with a Unified command would be deployed. The partners agreed to put overtime patrol units in the area to be able to respond quickly, however we would have very limited Officers in the Park to walk the area as in past years. As the Chief, I authored an

Operations Plan with a contingency to be able to augment personnel and provide an overall command as well as a communication plan should one become necessary.

7) I attended the Gerrish Township Board regular meeting as required.

8) I attended one Roscommon County Law Enforcement Command meeting held via an electronic media as we have for some months now.

9) I attended two GTFD/EMS Facilities Planning Committee meetings as a member of the appointed group.

10) I attended two 2022-2023 Budget meetings with the Township Board in preparation for presenting same to the public on August 16, 2021.

11) I attended a MACP Legislative Meeting in my role as a member of this committee that reviews and assesses positions on current legislation that effects Law Enforcement in Michigan. This meeting was held via an electronic media as well.

12) I participated in a meeting with all the partners regarding the status of the CAD/RMS/JMS Flex product and its serious deficiencies regarding a proper integration to be used for a common platform for all agencies.

13) I also amended our Use of Force Policy to reflect a duty to intervene which is a recommendation that has come out of the recent National spotlight on Law Enforcement.

14) We have begun to fill out a grant pre-application thorough the DOJ to explore possible funding of Body worn cameras. More to follow as information on the grant timeline is published.

15) I met with a citizen in my office regarding serious concerns over the Air B & B and VRBO short term rentals and their associated social problems that they can present to our community. The laws were explained, and the party was advised that any consideration of ordinances or local control pend the disposition of recent authored legislation where the State would prohibit locals from enacting any ordinance to restrict the operations of same.

16) The Department, Fire/EMS, CERT and ACT-NOW assisted with the running of the Higgins Lake Sunrise Run 5k, 10k and half marathon this month. The event was conducted without incident. Although the numbers were still reduced due to COVID-19 during the pre-registration, the event handled about 225 runners between the three runs.

17) This month saw a technology upgrade in Lt Patchin's office for an outdated Computer tower.

18) The Department provided Incident Command for the continued Food Distributions being held at the Roscommon Area Public Schools Bus Garage. There are several partners that we work with to accomplish these each month. The Gerrish Township CERT team helps us provide the necessary traffic direction and flow to keep all visitors in their cars to make provisions for COVID-19 precautions.

19) Lt Patchin and I met with Clerk Patchin and Building/Zoning Administrator Jansen regarding open issues with Attorney Hess's office that are legal issues in the Township that need attention.

20) I attended the Summer MACP Executive Professional Development Conference this month with highlighted training topics of:

A) A presentation by the Michigan HIDTA which stands for the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Agency to discuss current drug movements and enforcement concentrations currently deployed and resources available to Administrators.

B) A current legislative update from our Association lobbyist.

C) A program entitled "Leadership lessons from James Bond" presented by National speaker Chief Paul Cell which focused on doing the everyday things to make sure that you are a leader and not "just" a manager.

D) A Legal Update was provided by MLL Insurance Risk Management to include their litigation specialist to discuss current hot button issue and lawsuit trends in 2021.

E) We saw a presentation on “Avoiding the pitfalls of Last Chance employment agreements” put on by Kirk, Huth, Lange & Badalementi PLC

F) A class entitled “Duty to Intervene: Don’t just stand there, do something” put on by McGraw & Morris, P.C. the leaders in defending Police Officers and governmental units. Discussed were the current climate and the topic as it relates to these types of lawsuits in the post Derek Chauvin era of policing.

G) We saw another presentation on the leadership lessons learned from the Washington Navy Shipyard Shooting. The focus being on gaining intelligence and compiling same before bad acts occur. To connect the dots through employment background data. Where to go and how to get it to avoid tragedy.

H) “Leadership in times of Crisis” was presented by (Ret.) Detroit PD Chief James Craig. Chief Craig shared his recent experiences in Detroit during the unrest in the major cities in the Country and his experiences at LAPD, Portland Maine Police Department and Cincinnati PD during his tenures.

I) The last day speaker presented “Not by Chance Leadership”. He is a national speaker and current Department of Public Safety Chief in Alpharetta, Georgia which is a suburb to Atlanta Georgia. He talked about the importance of our greatest asset, our folks that work for us. Getting the team on the same page with the Department missions and the power of ownership. Building trust, cultivating healthy relationships from the top down. He focused heavily on everyday communications and the importance of same.

Also, while there, I attended the Northern Michigan Chiefs of Police Association quarterly meeting where I was re-elected to continue to be a trustee on the Executive Board for another year term.

I also attended the MACP Business meeting for the installation of Officers and heard all reports from the various committees that the Association provides.

I also attended the Annual Awards banquet to honor those Officers and families as they received medals of honor, valor, presidential awards and of course the very somber police cross presentations to the families left behind of Officers killed on duty in the past year.

In summation, the conference had one of the best if not the best training opportunities we have ever had. The topics were very relevant and well presented by all.
