Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 07-01-21 through 07-31-21

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 167 calls for service for the month of July 2021.

The Department reports 75 total citations recording 70 traffic violations, 5 Misdemeanor violations, 15 written verbal warnings, 3 Public Act 56 Violations. (See attached report for breakdown)

The Department also reports 5 custodial arrests for the monthly period. (See attached report for breakdown)

Training:

The Department reports no hours of training this month as we tend to the greater population of summer residents. (See attached breakdown)

- 1) I authored and attended the Police Department's Monthly work session update and delivered same at the meeting.

- 8) I participated with a review committee to go over the bids received to sealcoat, fix cracks, and paint the GTFD/EMS, Township General/compost and GTPD parking lots held at the Gerrish
