Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 01-01-22 through 01-31-22

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 75 calls for service for the month of January 2022.

The Department reports 4 custodial arrest statistics this month. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department reports 13 total citations listing 2 traffic violations, 8 Civil Infractions, 3 written verbal warnings and, 2 misdemeanor citations for the month. (See attached for breakdown).

Training:

The Department reports 59 total contact hours of continuing educational training.

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) I analyzed and prepared the 2021 Police Department Annual Report and distributed same to the board for review and have released same to the public on our website for consumption.
- 2) I attended the ACT-NOW Executive Board Meeting in my advisory capacity this month.
- 3) I conducted two staff meetings this month to focus on our continued success with managing open case files and discussing important Department personnel shortage issues that we face at this time.
- 4) I attended the regular Township Board work session meeting as required.
- 5) I attended the 911 Technical Advisory Committee meeting and presided over the election process and worked through the agenda as presented.
- 6) I was re-elected as the chair of the 911 Technical Board again for the 2021 year.
- 7) This month, I re-wrote the in-car video system policy and procedure to include adding Body Worn Camera (BWC) verbiage to same to prepare for the acquisition and deploying of the BWC technology in the near future.
- 8) I met with Watchguard-Motorola about their BWC/In-car video technology solution and to see how it would align to the grant we wrote and have been awarded for BWC technology.
- 9) I attended the January work session with the Township Board to go over operational items in the Department.

10) I have also begun investigating a Sponsored Cadet program to deploy as a way of trying to address future recruitment needs for the Department as retirement attritions begin to move through our Department.

11) I chaired a NMCAC Executive Board meeting in my elected chairperson role to officially conduct the business needs of the center via zoom while on Covid-19 leave and quarantine.

12) I met with the Lock-out Company and the Roscommon High School Assistant Principal to view an addition to our boots for the doors for the school security for active violence incidents. The new technology would allow blue tooth technology for lockdown announcements to each room consistently rather than the different options in each building. Items controlled both internally and externally for better coordination during the time of need. A quote for RAPS was to be drafted and sent to the school officials as technology money has been made available post Oxford School shooting in the State.

13) I drafted a conditional offer of employment to a Ferris State University student cadet currently in their academy with a first week of May 2022 completion of academy date. I await the signature of the cadet on this document to fill our current full time vacant position which has been vacant since September 2021.

14) Julie Hill and I attended a grant webinar to learn processes for our awarded Small, Rural and Tribal Body Worn Camera Federal Grant. We learned that there were only 19 agencies in Michigan to received same. 966 total grants were awarded from 2260 applicants in the United States. The grant will supply \$14,000.00 towards the technology to be implemented and deployed.

15) I attended a meeting of the user group to talk over beginning a process to obtain a CAD/RMS/JMS system as we move past last year's failure to be able to buy a platform that worked as advertised. A decision was made by all parties to move forward with trying to request information from various solutions once again.

16) The department and our CERT team supplied traffic safety for the Roscommon Area Christian Ministries Monthly Food Distributions held each month at the RAPS campus during the COVID-19 pandemic.

17) Over half our staff had Covid-19 this month despite being fully vaccinated and boosted and our schedule and activities were affected as one may imagine. Fortunately, all have successfully recovered and back to work at this time.

18) Lastly, I received letter of intent from Lt Grep Patchin to retire from the Gerrish Township Police Department with 30 years of service to same on June 10, 2022.
