March 14, 2024

Special Meeting called to Order 6:05 pm

That the Board enter into a special hearing on the 2024-2025 General Budget.

The budget is based on an estimate of .9548 mills generating approximately \$336,594.19 to support the General Fund. Also included in the final budget are the 3.03 mills Fire/EMS special assessment and 2.39 mills police special assessment, as reviewed at the Public Hearing held in August 2023. Wage adjustments are being proposed for full time, part time, seasonal, and election workers. Board priorities include software Update for the Township offices including implementing a Cemetery Program. Allocation of expenditure to ensure maintenance of current services. A raise for Township Clerk, Treasurer, Supervisor and Trustee positions are being sought. General Fund, Cemetery, Parks and Recreation, Community Park Marina, Bond Payments and Sanitation are being presented to the public for review and comment.
