

## **NOTICE TO BIDDERS**

### **Sealing of Existing Pavement (GERRISH TOWNSHIP)**

Gerrish Township is requesting bids for the preparation and sealing of the existing:

- 1) Gerrish Township Police Department Parking Lot
- 2) Gerrish Township Municipal Building Parking Lot
- 3) Gerrish Township Fire/EMS Department Parking Lot and Front and Rear Approach Ramps
- 4) Gerrish Township Cemetery

Bidders must visit each site and confirm the layout and square footage requirements and shall confirm their coverage area in the proposed bid.

The project may require more than one phase to allow 24-hour access to both the Police and Fire/EMS Departments. The access concept must be reviewed with each department head and shall be confirmed in the proposal.

The bid must include cleaning areas of dirt and debris, cracks cleaned and filled with rubber, any chemical weed/grass killers must be registered by the EPA and acceptable to authorities having jurisdiction, coal tar based asphalt sealer with washed silica sand with latex additive for extra durability/elasticity, two coat process with second coat only being applied after the first coat has dried (thickness shall be to the manufacturers recommendations and shall be specified in the bid).

**Separate bid amount being requested for each of the four locations listed above with a separate amount for painting lines per existing lot layouts with commercial grade striping equipment and material, if applicable.**

The contractor shall manage and comply with all applicable State and/or Federal Safety programs and supply proof of insurance to meet or exceed the minimum required by the Township.

All waste generated shall be properly disposed of off-site, any and all costs for disposal shall be included within the bid.

Any exceptions, changes and/or recommendations shall be noted within the bid proposal.

Sealed bids will be received until 4:00 PM on June 30, 2021 at the Gerrish Township Hall, 2997 E. Higgins Lake Drive, Roscommon, MI 48653.
