

July is National Parks and Recreation Month

We invite you to visit the three parks that Gerrish Township owns and manages: Gerrish Municipal Park, by the Township offices, Gerrish Township Park, on Carlos Avenue, and Gerrish Marina and Community Park.

We are happy to share these highlights of park improvements made in the past year:

Municipal Park: resurfaced the two tennis courts and added lines for four pickleball courts, installed side fencing around the courts, added seven polywood benches (through the Memory Bench Program), added a Free Little Library with young children's books.

Township Park: expanded parking, replaced the split-rail fence around the park, undated signage, bought a new flagpole with light, added one polywood bench, repaired and painted all picnic tables, completed a shoreline redesign to better manage erosion.

Here are key plans in store for 2024: add more park benches, install a security camera at the tennis courts, renovate the bathroom building and add play equipment at Township Park. Also, the Parks Committee will update the Gerrish Township 5-Year Recreation Plan. To support that, they will make a survey available to all residents this summer. Please plan to take the survey to share your feedback and input as we work to ensure Gerrish parks are meeting your needs.
