SUPERVISOR'S REPORT July 14, 2020

- On June 11th, along with a representative from the RCRC, we met with residents living on Warren Ave. to discuss road drainage issues. The meeting resulted in ditching and a culvert being installed by the RCRC. Residents living on Warren Ave. participated in the project by moving critter cages and mailboxes.
- On Friday June 12th, I was joined by Chief Brian Hill and Tim O'Rourke from the RCRC. We met with residents from Huntington Shores to discuss parking issues on Townline and W. Higgins Lake Dr. The substance of this resident meeting is highlighted in Chief Hills report dated 6/29/2020.
- I attended the budget hearing for Gerrish Township Police, Fire and EMS on Wednesday June 17.
- On June 18th I attended a meeting held at Attorney Scott Hess office. Also attending were Trustee Jim Lippert, Chief Brian Hill, Lieutenant Greg Patchin, and Building and Zoning Administrator Jason Jansen. Gerrish Township zoning issues were discussed at that meeting.
- On Wednesday June 24 along with marina manager Steve Myer we met with Scott's Excavating at the Gerrish Township Park to obtain an estimate for delivering and moving beach sand and removing selective tree stumps.
- On Thursday June 25th I met with residents living on Pine Bluffs to hear their concerns regarding water drainage from the road onto their property. Rex Wolfson, Roscommon County Drain Commissioner also attended. Rex highlighted the root cause of their problem and laid out the process for extending the existing drain should the residents chose to pursue this issue.
- I attended the monthly township work session on Thursday July 2nd to prepare for tonight's meeting.
- On Thursday July 9th I attended the Planning Commission meeting.
- On Monday July 13, Treasurer Tulgetski and I interviewed two candidates that applied for the Gerrish Township assessor services.
