Special meeting called to order at 5:00pm. Audio Present: Supervisor Udy, Clerk Patchin, Treasurer Tulgetske, Trustee Lippert and Trustee Link. Also, audio present: Chief Hill and 2 citizens

Motion by Lippert, supported by Tulgetske: CARRIED  
that the Board approve the agenda as presented.

Motion by Udy, supported by Lippert: CARRIED  
that the Board enter the Public Hearing on creating a Special Assessment District under the provisions of P.A.81 of 1989 to provide police services to the residents of the Township.

Special Assessment roll created at 2.26 mills (\$710,059.00), same as previous year, in which all parcels of land to be assessed are described together with the names of respective owners of record and a total amount to be assessed against each parcel. Such roll to be presented at the Regular Meeting September 8, 2020 for approval. No wage increases were sought.

Public Comments and Questions: Chief Hill explained the 18-month projection of the Police Department budget including the training dollars that are required to be budgeted to receive the MTJC funding. He also explained the 2021-2022 budget does not include a patrol car purchase but includes the radio payment on the 800mhz radios. Capital projects include resealing of parking lot along with potential roof replacement.

Motion by Udy, supported by Tulgetske: CARRIED  
that the Board exit the Special Assessment Hearing at 5:06pm and re-enter the Special Meeting.
