### **SUPERVISOR'S REPORT JUNE 8, 2021**

- May 12, I worked with the marina staff helping to install both docks and boat lifts.
- On May 18<sup>th</sup>. I participated in a zoom call with both Gerrish and Lyon Township residents discussing progress on the sanitary sewer system. Later that afternoon I participated on a zoom call with a representative from Senator Debbie Stabenow's office to discuss our sewer project and to request earmark funding from the Senator.
- On the morning of May 20<sup>th</sup>. I helped install a boat lift at the marina and in the afternoon, we placed a zoom call to Congressman John Moolenaar and Congressman Jack Bergman to ask for a grant to help fund the sewer project.
- The township Board is aware of trash / recycle/and yard waste service issues to our residents.
- On May 17,24, and June 1and 7<sup>th</sup>, along with Treasurer Tulgetske, we participated in the weekly zoom call seeking grant funding opportunities for our sewer project. Our team will be traveling to Delton Township (near Kalamazoo) on Monday June 14<sup>th</sup>. to get a first-hand look at a step sewer system that has been servicing Delton Township residents and businesses for several years,
- On Friday afternoon Friday June 4, along with Treasurer Tulgetske and engineers from Fleis&Vandenbrink, we applied for a grant that will help fund our sewer project. The grant application is from Senator Debbie Stabenow's office.
- On Thursday June 3<sup>rd</sup>, I chaired the monthly township board work session to prepare for tonight's meeting.
- This morning I attended the monthly meeting of the Roscommon County Transportation Authority. Call for rides is on the increase on the county bus system as more residents feel comfortable using the service. An addition to the bus garage size will increase later this year to accommodate a larger bus fleet, modernize the propane and gasoline furling stations, and increase the propane fuel storage that will save the authority money by purchasing propane in larger quantities. Additions to building security are forthcoming as well.
