July 7th

- Our new ice cream freezer has been delivered and is stocked with five different packaged ice cream.
- Gas pump needed repair due to worn out reset switch.
- Had to have tree service cut and remove two large dead limbs which were right above the children sand box, just before holiday.
- The 4th of July weekend was very busy as usual . Marina launch ramp was closed two of the three days due to being full around midday.
- No single vehicles were turned away, very few spots were left though.
- Gas sales last 30 days were \$46,898.65 which is approx.. 5900 gallons. That's down about 1000 gallons from 2021.
- Apparel sales last 30 days were \$1381.52.
- Ice cream, pop and water sales were \$164.00.
- Ice sales were \$658.44.
- Staffing scheduling has been challenging due to the weather this year.
- Would like to thank all the marina employees for their hard work, without them it would not be possible.
