### *Gerrish Township Police Monthly Report 06-01-23 through 06-30-23*

The Gerrish Township Police Department responded to a total of 133 calls for service for the month of June 2023.

The Department reports 1 custodial arrest statistics for this listed period, however there are many reports submitted to the Prosecuting attorney seeking warrants that have not been returned yet for status update. (See attached report for breakdown).

The Department reports 13 total citations listing 9 traffic violations, 1 Misdemeanor violation, and no written warnings for this listed period. (See attached for breakdown).

#### Training:

62.5 training hours are reported during this listed period. (See attached detail document).

Chief Hill highlighted activity for the reported month is as follows:

- 1) I attended the ACT-NOW Executive Board meeting in my Advisory role.
- 2) I attended the Gerrish Township Board work session as required to update the board on the operational status of the Department.
- 3) The Department hosted 2 days of First Aid classes for the second quarter CERT training initiative.
- 4) I met with area Law Enforcement partners regarding the South Higgins Lake State Park for the purpose of discussing the Fourth of July potential activity at the park and a needs assessment for an enforcement effort at the park this year. We reviewed the data from past years, and it was determined that no formal task force with a Unified command would be deployed. The partners agreed to put overtime patrol units in the area to be able to respond quickly, however we would have limited Officers in the Park to walk the area as in past years. As the Chief, I authored an Operations Plan with a contingency to be able to augment personnel and provide an overall command as well as a communication plan should one become necessary.
- 5) I attended the Gerrish Township Board regular meeting as required.
- 6) I attended one Roscommon County Law Enforcement Command meeting held at Fred's of Roscommon.
- 7) I attended and presented the proposed 2024-2025 budget with the Gerrish Township Board. No changes were requested by the board in anticipation of an August public hearing.

- 8) I attended a MACP Legislative Meeting in my role as a member of this committee that reviews and assesses positions on current legislation that affects Law Enforcement in Michigan. This meeting was held via electronic media as well.
- 9) The Department, Fire/EMS, CERT and ACT-NOW assisted with the running of the Higgins Lake Sunrise Run 1 mile, 5k, 10k and half marathon this month. The event was conducted without incident. The event managed about 250 runners between the four runs.
- 10) The Department provided Incident Command for the continued Food Distributions being held at the Roscommon Area Public Schools Bus Garage. There are several partners that we work with to accomplish these each month. The Gerrish Township CERT team helps us provide the necessary traffic direction and flow to keep all visitors in their cars.
- 11) I attended the Summer MACP Professional Development Conference this month. Several leadership topic breakout sessions were presented on recruiting and retention, resilience, health, and emerging technology as it relates to automobiles and their GPS capabilities.
- 12) Lt Muszynski and Officer Wybraniec attended the Higgins Lake Foundation Lake Saver program displaying the Department's Ranger Unit #241. Explaining its uses and operations to fourth grades classes that attend to learn more about Higgins Lake and what it takes to make things healthy and safe for generations.
- 13) Our new patrol unit #4, a 2023 Ford SUV AWD Police Interceptor was placed into service after being upfitted accordingly for patrol use.
- 14) I participated in a programmatic and audit call on behalf of the NMCAC as the chairperson of the organization to answer questions regarding our service because of a regular audit of our programs for the State of Michigan grant we received from the MDHHS DVS.
- 15) I attended a 4 hour zoom training as a refresher on the Child Death Review Team (CDRT) for Roscommon County.
- 16) I attended a meeting requested by the Good Shepherd United Methodist of the North to discuss the new Montessori School to occupy the old day care wing in the Fall of 2023. We reviewed their building and discussed their need to author and maintain a proper Emergency Action Plan for the school. I was accompanied by Chief Fisher of the Fire/EMS, Roscommon County Emergency Manager, Undersheriff Lowe, Roscommon County SRO Mike Zrebski.
- 17) I hosted a NMCAC Sustainability Committee meeting at the GTPD Training Room for the purpose of providing our plans as a committee to address our portion of the strategic plan for the center.
- 18) The Police Department brought back our Coffee and Conversation with a Cop event this month. We had to discontinue due to the COVID-19 Pandemic. The event was held at the Bird and the Bear Bakery in Roscommon and was well attended. Another event will occur in the Fall of 2023.
- 19) All final inspections were achieved with our newly installed whole building generator replacement as required.
- 20) I met with Supervisor Udy and Attorney Hess regarding Township legal issues.
- 21) I attended a LEPT meeting to discuss emergency planning for Roscommon County as a Law Enforcement representative.
- 22) I conducted one staff meeting this month where we reviewed open case files, summer Riparian, PA 56 of 2012 Enforcement processes and other locations of usual public interest at lake sites.
- 23) The Department conducted a peer interview in preparation for sponsoring an individual in the August 14, 2023, at KCC Regional Police Academy.

24) Officers Ellis and Taylor attended an orientation to services for the NMCAC which provides the process we follow with investigating Child CSC/Neglect and Abuse cases regarding the use of Forensic Interviews and other trauma related therapy services available to better assist our Victims of such activity.

25) I attended a Northern Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police (NMACP) meeting while at the summer MACP Professional Development Conference in Bellaire, Mi.

The ACT-NOW/GTPD Golf Outing fundraiser will go on as planned on August 12, 2023, at the Redwood Golf Course with a 9:00 a.m. registration and 10:00 a.m. shotgun start. This is our largest fundraiser for our benevolent projects. Please join us and bring your friends!

We will be having our ACT-NOW Annual Meeting & Picnic at the Gerrish Township Community Park and Marina on 7-17-23 at 6:00 p.m. ACT-NOW/GTPD will be supplying all the food, beverages, and table service. 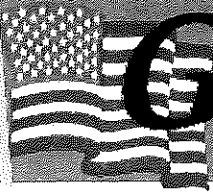

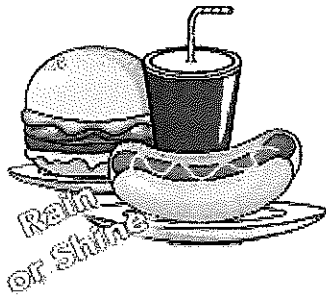

## Busy 4th of July for Gerrish PD

This was one of the busiest 4th of July holidays that our area has experienced in quite a while. The State parks were full every day and the general population soared in our local community.

Between the dates of July 1st - 5th, the Gerrish Police Department took 32 various complaints/calls for service, wrote 32 citations which included 22 parking violations, four County ORV Ordinance tickets, one PA 56 violation, one Driving While License Revoked, and various other traffic violations. There was also one Domestic Violence arrest.

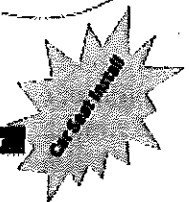

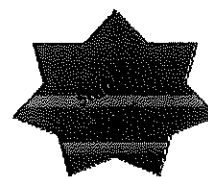
