

Trustee Report for Jim Ostling – February 2025

- 2/3/25 Talked with RCRC Brad Dalstrom regarding road end projects and the report done in 1993. Notified there was a later report
- Met with Atty Hess and Sup Hill to discuss GLUA questions. What are next steps in our responsibilities for GLUA
- Individual Phone Conversations with GLUA members Hall, Lamb, Barnwell and Czech over several days regarding next steps
- Met in Prudenville with Mark Jarski of the CMHD on 2/5 to look at their FETCH Gis database.
- Attended Gerrish Work Session on Feb 6

- Attended Special Township Meeting 2/20 to discuss next steps for GLUA
- Met with members of the Higgins Lake Land Conservancy regarding HOH and how we can work together for the betterment of the lake
- Obtained a report from RCRC regarding the status of road ends at lake 2/2. Received a copy of the updated road end report from 2010. Consolidated data from both reports to compare.
- Met with Steve King and Mark Jarski at health Dept 2/21 regarding the process of entering data into the FETCH Gis database and timing.
- Participated in Zoom Call with Treasurer Anderson, Commissioner Morley and Congressman Bergman to discuss status of grant funds now that the sewer system is no longer an option for Lyon Township and GLUA is in the process of being dissolved. He indicated that those funds were not available for anything other than a municipal sewer project. The rules under the original appropriation as well as the current attitude in Washington will not allow for any alternatives.
